The Jung Family Dynasty of tennis was so entwined in the sport that the USTA recognized all six Jung family members as the 1985 National Tennis Family of the Year. Gene embodied the diversity of the sport in Southern California, and this award reflects the accomplishment of increasing interest and awareness of the sport in diverse and multicultural communities.

From a First Family of tennis in Southern California, Ryan Redondo has been the driving force behind the renaissance of Barnes Tennis Center and Youth Tennis San Diego. Over 60% of the children require financial assistance to join the programs, and YTSD provides scholarships for families who cannot afford program fees. Demand for after school programs and guidance pathways reflects the growing need of area schools, neighborhoods, and families to provide positive alternatives for youngsters of all cultures and backgrounds, regardless of their means.
