MINUTES OF THE GENERAL MEETING  
Tuesday, March 9, 2021 via Zoom Online Meeting  
Next Executive Meeting, April 13, 2021 at 7:00 PM  
Next General Meeting Tuesday, June 8, 2021 at 7:00 PM

- I. CALL TO ORDER: 7:01 PM. Called to order by Carol Jory. Attendees were Cara Beltran, John Broderick, Andrew Cretella, Jeff Greenwald, M.A. Hillier, Jerome Jayapal, Josh Jorgensen, Carol Jory, Jim Lackritz, Steve Leffler, Randie Lettington, Conan Lorenzo, Carolyn Nichols, Anne Podney, Matt Previdi, Ryan Redondo, Amit Shah, Simon Shen, and Todd Sprague.
- II. MINUTES: January 19, 2021 General Meeting Minutes MSP.
- III. PRESIDENT'S REPORT: Carol Jory noted that other states and districts seemed to be further along with organized tennis leagues and tournaments than Southern California. Balboa Tennis Club and other clubs are not yet allowing leagues but will re-evaluate when COVID-19 restrictions are revised. Other local clubs are very busy, several with many new members.
- IV. TREASURER'S REPORT: Jim Lackritz reported there was not much activity on the current P&L statement due to the pandemic limiting District events. MSP
- V. COMMITTEE REPORTS:
  - a. Sanctions and Scheduling: Jim Lackritz reported that John Chanfreau had requested sanction for a two-day event at Rancho Santa Fe. A survey to potential and past tournament players was sent out via various channels. So far 360 responses have been received and it is hoped that over 400 will be received. A presentation of the results will be made at the June 8th General Meeting.
  - b. Budget: Jim Lackritz discussed the pros and cons of conducting a financial audit or a review. Due to the minimal activity in the past year and stable management over many years, it was felt that this would not be the optimal time to do so.
  - c. USTA League: Randie Lettington reported that 18 and over and 40 and over and mixed leagues will resume soon. 175 league teams will start play March 15th. 18 teams that needed home courts are being graciously hosted at Barnes! Matt Previdi noted that Vista Tennis Club is available for hosting teams as well. Jerome Jayapal and Matt offered to investigate how more high school venues could be made available for league tennis.
  - d. Nominations: The Nominating Committee recommended that John Chanfreau, Shatoo Mohamad and Hillary Park be approved as SDDTA Board of Directors members, contingent upon completion of the Safe Sport Exam. MSP.
  - e. Collegiate: Anne Podney reported that SDDTA scholarship information has been sent to all local college coaches, all Southern California Tennis on Campus (TOC) captains and that Conan Lorenzo has sent the information to all USPTA pros. She asked that Board members and the Tennis Liaison Committee further disseminate the information. Deadline is August 1, 2021.
  - f. Tennis Fest: Carol Jory reported that Jerome Jayapal previously offered to chair Tennis Fest but Balboa has cancelled all league and tournament activities for the time being and there is too much uncertainty for the next 4-5 months it would take to organize the event. Therefore, a motion to forgo the event this year was made. MSP
