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MINUTES OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETING  
Tuesday, April 13, 2021 via Zoom Online Meeting  
Next General Meeting is Tuesday, June 8, 2021 at 7:00 PM

- I. CALL TO ORDER: 7:02 PM. Called to order by Carol Jory. Attendees were John Broderick, Carol Jory, Jim Lackritz, Steve Leffler, Randie Lettington, Anne Podney and Jeff Anderson (SDDTA Office Administrator).
- II. MINUTES: March 9, 2021 General Meeting Minutes. MSP.
- III. PRESIDENT'S REPORT: Carol reported that Tony Perez resigned from SDDTA. She will recommend John Broderick to the nominating committee for approval at the next General Meeting as Vice President for the remainder of the year. Carol appointed Anne as Chair of the Tournament Committee to replace Tony.
- IV. TREASURER'S REPORT: Jim Lackritz reported that the District's index funds are up approximately 20%. A portion of the SCTA grant is expected by May 1st. MSP
- V. COMMITTEE REPORTS:
  - a. SAN DIEGO TENNIS HALL OF FAME: John Broderick reported that the SDTHOF induction ceremony, which was deferred from last summer due to the pandemic, would be held the first Saturday, Aug. 28th of the District tournament, 4PM at Balboa Tennis Club.
  - b. NOMINATIONS: Anne Podney reported that the committee would like to nominate Eric Mann to the board. He is assistant coach at City College and who works with Jamie Jones. MSP
  - c. TOURNAMENT: Anne Podney reported that entry fees for the 2021 District Tournament will increase to \$48 for singles and \$28 for doubles. Hiromi Sasano will be Tournament Director with Eric Mann Referee and Jeff Anderson assisting where needed. No late entries will be accepted. A discussion was held regarding problems with the Serve Tennis program. A detailed report will be made at the June meeting after the Tournament Committee meets.
  - d. TOURNAMENT PLAYER SURVEY: Jim Lackritz reported on his initial analysis of survey results of area tennis players as to their preferences concerning various possible tournament formats. To date, there are 560 responses, greater than expected. He will present his findings to the General Meeting in June.
  - e. LEAGUE: Randie Lettington reported that we are halfway through spring season. She is starting to register summer league. Sectionals must be completed by the end of summer. SDSU has made courts available but Barnes is heavily booked for summer camps.
- VI. OLD BUSINESS: Annual Banquet – Jim Lackritz advised that a decision on holding the Awards Dinner and producing the SDDTA Yearbook should be postponed until after the Balboa tournaments.
- VII. NEW BUSINESS: \$500 is being given to Gompers Preparatory Academy in memory of Jim Winters to be used for their Athletic Program. MSP. It was suggested that our next newsletter be issued around the end of June or early July.
- VIII. ADJOURNMENT: The meeting was adjourned at 8:37 PM.
