Tuesday, January 19, 2021 via Zoom Online Meeting

- I. CALL TO ORDER: 7:01 PM. Called to order by Carol Jory. - II. MINUTES: December 8, 2020 General Meeting Minutes MSP.
- III. PRESIDENT'S REPORT: Carol is hoping that restrictions on tennis might lessen starting in mid-spring as the COVID 19 vaccine rolls out. She reported the sad news of the recent passing of Vice President Jim Winters who was on the SDDTA Board since 2011. - IV. TREASURER'S REPORT: Jim Lackritz reported the 2020 financials were significantly positive due to minimized expenses. MSP. The Finance Committee met and the proposed 2021 budget is an agenda item.
- V. COMMITTEE REPORTS:
  - a. Sanctions and Scheduling: Jim Lackritz reported that he and Tony Perez met with Marla Messing and Madeline Segura and were informed that SCTA allows two sanctioned tournaments the same weekend if the tournaments are separated by 25 miles or more and this could be considered for San Diego tournaments. Also discussed was the need to survey area players as to which tournament formats might be the most appealing for their participation as USTA is encouraging shorter tournaments with various scoring systems and more round-robin formats to provide a better player experience. Todd Sprague is discussing tournament options with local tournament directors as well.
  - b. Budget: Jim Lackritz reviewed the proposed 2021 budget for the District. Cuts were made in several areas to align the budget with proposed SCTA grant reductions in 2021. The budget balances anticipated income and expense within \$1,000 based on current assumptions. MSP.
  - c. Bylaws: Revisions to the District Bylaws were presented. A discussion was held. MSP 20-2-0.
  - d. USTA League: Randie Lettington reported that 3-line leagues are hoped to resume for the Spring Season.
  - e. Nominations: Sandie Kindred reported that there are several openings for the Board and the nomination committee encourages all board members to look for candidates.
